<b>Access description:</b>	Via the A2, exit Leobersdorf, direction St. Pölten - Traisen, signposted from Traisen. Via the A1, exit St.Pölten Süd, direction Mariazell - Traisen, signposted from Traisen.

### **Show rules and admission regulations:**

Only dogs registered in the stud book of the ÖKV or in another stud book recognised by the FCI are admitted. Sick dogs or dogs suspected of being sick are excluded. The organiser shall not be liable for any damage caused by a dog, including theft of a dog. any liability obligation. Each exhibitor is liable for any damage caused by his dog. Dogs in the working dog class must pass a TSB check before the stand inspection. Only dogs that receive the highest predicate "a" (pronounced) for the TSB - evaluation can be awarded the rating "VA".

- Dogs with the predicate "vh" (present) or "ng" (insufficient) can still participate in the competition.
- Dogs with a pass (T2) are placed at the end of the V group and dogs with a fail (T3) are placed at the end of the SG group.
- Dogs that do not let off (T1), lack obedience (T4) or are disqualified cannot take part in the further competition.

### **Rating mirror:**

"a" = TSB is pronounced leaves off.

T1 = TSB does not drop

T2 = TSB present

T3 = TSB not sufficient

T4 = aborted due to lack of leadership skills

DI = disqualified

Should a dog fall ill after it has been inspected, it must be presented to the veterinary surgeon in charge of the show area. An excused withdrawal is only possible on presentation of the written certificate of the veterinary surgeon or with the express permission of the officiating judge. The issued certificate of illness must be handed over to the officiating judge without fail.

Dogs withdrawn without an excuse will receive the mark "unsatisfactory" and will be banned from events and from the studbook for a period of 6 months.

Only dogs are eligible for the winner title and the **V selection (VA)**,

.) that are licensed and have received the **TSB rating "pronounced" at the licensing**.

(Dogs from abroad, where no licensing takes place, are excluded from this).

.) who have a complete set of teeth in perfect condition.

.) which have at least the training mark **FCI IGP 2**.

.) which originate from licensing and performance breeding.

.) showing a HD status normal or almost normal and an ED status normal or almost normal.

Males which are to enter the V selection class for the second time must carry the training mark **FCI IGP 3**, bitches the training mark **FCI IGP 2**.

"V" in the working class can only be awarded to dogs which have the HD "a" stamp and the ED stamp with the result normal, almost normal or still approved in the pedigree and, if over 3 ½ years old, are licensed. Excluded from this are dogs which are abroad where no inspections take place.

### **Utility dog class:**

Dogs in the working dog class **must have** at least the following training mark:

IPO ZTP, IGP 1, an examination of a recognised examination regulation of the WUSV or a HGH examination. (If necessary, a confirmation from the national association must be submitted with the entry).

### **Open class:**

Dogs in the Open Class do not have a training mark.

**Offspring groups:**

At least five dogs must be shown, which may have both hair varieties. Dogs from the junior classes may also be shown. All dogs presented must be of the standing type. Within the group they are to be lined up in the order of stock coat and then long coat.

**Breeding groups:**

A breeding group consists of at least four, at most 5 dogs from one kennel. All animals of the breeding group must be presented to the judge as a closed group and must have the same type of coat. The breeder is free to present several breeding groups if necessary. The judging of the breeding groups takes place on Sunday after the working class bitches.

**TSB - Review:**

Registration on site is required for the TSB inspection. The order of the work is determined by the registration. The TSB inspection is carried out according to point 6 (character test) of the valid licensing regulations.

Dogs that are particularly convincing in the TSB test are singled out at the end of the gait test.

**Official veterinary supervision:**

Dogs brought onto the show grounds must have been vaccinated against rabies at least 1 month before and no longer than 12 months ago. An appropriate vaccination certificate clearly stating the identity of the dog must be presented.

**Other notes:**

Only one owner may be named in the catalogue. The entry will only be accepted if proof of payment of the full entry fee is provided.

**Privacy Policy:**

We would like to point out that the data given will be processed by computer and printed in the show catalogue. The result lists with the names of the owners will be published on the internet. The data will be passed on to the SV (Verein für Deutsche Schäferhunde). Photographs will be taken at the event and the photos will also be published for internal club purposes without any remuneration being claimed.
