Access description: Coming **from Graz** follow A9 to Upper Austria, at the highway junction Knoten Wels follow signs to E56/A8 direction E552/Passau/Germany/Ried im Innkreis/Pichl bei Wels. Take exit 19-Pichl bei Wels in the direction of Pichl bei Wels/Bad Schallerbach/OÖ. Follow the B134 and B137 in the direction of Passau/Schärding until the Andorf exit.

Coming **from Vienna**, follow the A1 to the Wels Nord/B137 junction in Wels, take exit 17-Wels-Nord on the A25/E552. At the highway junction Knoten Haid follow the signs to A25/E552 direction E56/Germany/Wels/Passau. Take exit 19-Pichl bei Wels towards Pichl bei Wels/Bad Schallerbach/OÖ. Follow the B134 and B137 towards Passau/Schärding until the Andorf exit.

Coming **from Germany** from all directions, take the Pocking exit (no highway vignette is required) B512 towards Schärding, take the Schärding B137 exit, follow the B137 to the Andorf exit

Show regulations and admission regulations:

Only dogs registered in the ÖKV studbook or in another studbook recognized by the FCI or the WUSV are eligible.

From the age of 24 months (working, open and veteran classes), only dogs with an HD/ED stamp with the rating "normal" (FCI-A) or "fast normal" (FCI-B) entered in the pedigree are permitted.

Sick dogs or dogs suspected of being sick are excluded.

The organizer excludes all liability for any damage caused by a dog, including the theft of a dog.

Each exhibitor is liable for any damage caused by his dog.

Dogs in the working dog class must be checked before the stand test with regard to their unconditional manageability and controllability, their instinctive disposition, their mental and physical resilience and their self-confidence.

The "VA" rating can only be awarded to dogs that are controllable and that receive the highest rating of "a" for the TSB evaluation.

Dogs with the predicate "vh" (present) or "ng" (not sufficient) can still take part in the competition.

Dogs with a pass (T2) are placed at the end of the V group or with a fail (T3) at the end of the SG group.

Dogs that do not release (T1), have a lack of obedience (T4) or are disqualified cannot take part in the rest of the competition.

Evaluation mirror:

"a" = TSB can be pronounced.

T1 = does not drain

T2 = TSB present

T3 = TSB not sufficient

T4 = cancelled due to lack of leadership

DI = disqualified

If a dog should fall ill after it has been sampled, it must be presented to a veterinarian—An excused withdrawal is only possible upon presentation of a written certificate from the trusted veterinarian or with the express permission of the officiating judge.

The issued sickness certificate must be handed over to the officiating judge.

In all other cases where dogs are withdrawn without justification, a ban from the event and a ban from the studbook for a period of 6 months and the rating "unsatisfactory" will be issued.

Only dogs are eligible for the winner's title and the **V selection (VA)**,

) that are licensed and have received the **TSB rating "pronounced" at licensing.**

(Dogs from abroad, where no licensing takes place, are excluded from this).

) that have a complete, perfect set of teeth.

) that have at least the **FCI IGP 2** training mark.

) that originate from licensing and performance breeding.

) that show a normal or almost normal HD status and a normal or almost normal ED status.

) the dog must not be inbred closer than 3-3, 4-2, 2-4

Dogs that are to enter the V selection class for the second time must bear the **FCI IGP 3** training mark, bitches the **FCI IGP 2** training mark.

"V" in the working dog class can only be awarded to dogs that have the HD and ED stamp with the findings normal (FCI-A) or almost normal (FCI-B) in the pedigree and, if over 3 ½ years old, are licensed. Excluded from this are dogs that are located abroad and are subject to other recognized breeding regulations. If necessary, a corresponding confirmation (German or English) must be provided by the responsible association at the time of registration in the case of unclear tests and licensing. There is no entitlement to registration and recognition.

Only dogs that are not bred closer than 3-3, 4-2 or 2-4 can be awarded the winner's title.

Working dog class:

Dogs in the working dog class must have successfully passed an SVÖ/SV character assessment or an equivalent recognized character assessment - valid from the date of litter 1.1.2022

Dogs in the working dog class **must** have at least one of the following training characteristics:

- International Utility Dog Test (FCI IGP ZTP, FCI IGP 1-3)
- Herding dog test HGH
- International Tracking Dog Test (FCI IFH2)
- Agility test (A2)
- Obedience test (O2)
- Rescue dog test (RH-F, RH-FL, RH-T, RH-W, RH-L) - level B in each case
- Or a training label recognized as equivalent - e.g. SV ZAP
- Service dog tests - also outside the SVÖ/SV areas

Open class:

Open class dogs do not have a training mark.

Offspring groups:

At least five dogs must be shown that can have both coat varieties. Dogs from the junior classes may also be shown. All dogs presented must be stand patterned. Within the group, they are to be presented in the order of stock coat and then long stock coat.

Breeding groups:

A breeding group consists of a minimum of three and a maximum of four dogs from one kennel. All animals in the breeding group must be presented as a closed group to the officiating judge and must have the same type of coat. The breeder is free to present several breeding groups if necessary. Judging of the breeding groups takes place on Sunday after the working dog class for bitches.

TSB - Review:

Registration on site is required for the TSB inspection. The order of work is determined by the number of registrations received.

The TSB test is carried out in accordance with point 6 (character test) of the valid licensing regulations, whereby tested and certified helpers are used.

Official veterinary supervision:

Dogs brought onto the show grounds must have been vaccinated against rabies at least 1 month beforehand and no more than 12 months ago. A corresponding vaccination certificate clearly stating the identity of the dog must be presented.

Other notes:

Only one owner can be named in the catalogue. The entry will only be accepted if proof of payment of the full entry fee is provided.

Privacy policy:

We would like to point out that the data provided will be processed electronically and printed in the exhibition catalogue. The result lists with the names of the owners will be published on the Internet. The data will be passed on to the SV (Verein für Deutsche Schäferhunde). Photographs will be taken at the event and the photos will also be published for internal club purposes without any compensation being claimed.
